



HELPFUL HINTS FOR PARENTS AND CLASSROOM ETIQUETTE FOR STUDENTS

FOR PARENTS

- Let us know if we have your correct email or need another email address added to the list for the best communication.
- Check dates, times and locations of dress rehearsals and performances carefully and mark them on your calendar.
- All students need to attend dress rehearsals and performances.
- Costumes: Broadway Bound provides most of the performers costuming needs. We will send home a spreadsheet 2-3 weeks prior to show time with some basic items that will need to be provided from home. It's helpful to label everything a student wears/brings.
- Tickets for shows can be bought online about two weeks prior to performance. Any remaining tickets will be sold at the door.
- Tickets are \$5 and every seat needs a ticket. Children 4 and under are free (with the exception of the Company Troupe Show, for which all seats require a paid ticket).
- DVDs of any past or upcoming Broadway Bound performance can be ordered. The link goes directly to the DVD company and is not affiliated with Broadway Bound in any way.

FOR PERFORMERS

- Please use restroom before class.
- Wear the proper footwear (closed toe shoes that stay on feet for church space, no shoes for SV space).
- Dropped off and picked up on time.
- Bring scripts as needed.
- Bring a positive attitude and a smile.
- Attend all classes. (We understand illness, varying vacation dates and mandatory school events. If you must miss, please send an email to the teacher to let them know.)
- If it's not yours, don't touch it!
- Please keep your hands to yourselves, unless it's part of the class instruction.



PERFORMANCE TIME

- House opens 30 minutes prior to show time.
- Cast and crew only in the theatre until house opens.
- Seating is general admission, first-come, first-served (no reserving seats before house opens)
- You may take non-flash photography.
- You may video performance as long as you are courteous of patrons around you and do not post on social mediawebsites.
- Turn off all electronic devices.
- No food or beverages in the theatre (bottled water is permitted). Same goes for performers.
- After the show, take all items that belong to you and leave all items that belong to us.
- Clap, cheer and laugh! And what performer doesn't love a standing ovation?!

BEHAVIOR POLICY

To ensure that all students have a positive experience and are not interrupted by an excessively disruptive or misbehaving student,we are now implementing a new behavior policy. The steps are:

1st strike: Student will be given a verbal warning. (Parent will be notified by email.)

2nd strike: Student will be asked to sit aside during class. (Parent will receive a phone call and will need to observe the next class.)
